Who Are We?

Reeves-Reed Arboretum was originally a private home built in 1889 for the Wisner family, and is now a suburban conservancy dedicated to environmental and horticultural education for children and adults and to the enjoyment of nature through the professional care and preservation of a historic country estate.

Distinct from a park, an arboretum is an educational conservancy promoting environmental protection. Trees, shrubs and herbaceous plants are conserved and identified in their natural settings for study and appreciation. Native flora, new plant introductions and unusual specimens that can be grown in this region are also on display.
